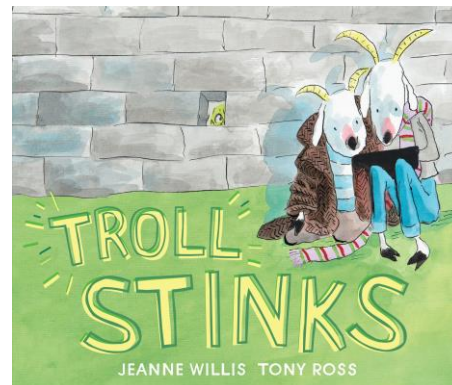


Early Years News 8
