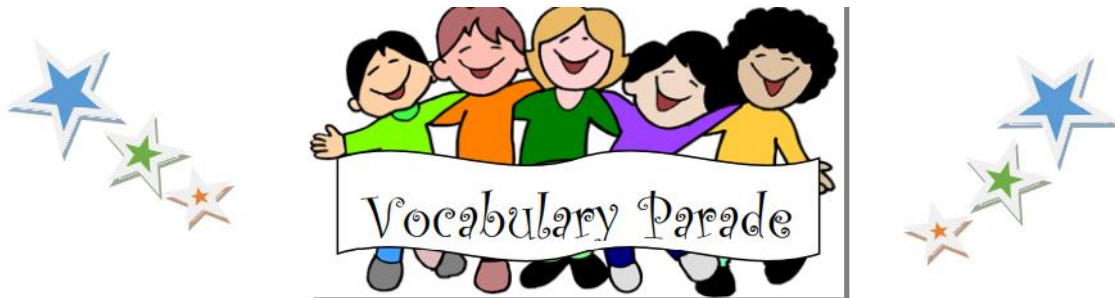




Dear parents and carers,

For World Book Day this year we are inviting the children to come to school dressed up as an amazing word for a huge vocabulary parade in school.



Step 1: Choose a word out of the dictionary. Your teacher can help you to choose a word if you wish.

Step 2: Create a costume. Use what you have at home. The costume can be any creative interpretation of your word.

Step 3: Remember to include your vocabulary word and definition on your costume as a label.

For example: If a student chooses the word "mythical" they could wear a unicorn outfit/ the word "monochrome" could have a black and white outfit/ the word "fearsome" could be a dragon costume or a monster mask/ the word "floral" could be a flowery dress.

A vocabulary parade creates a positive discussion about new vocabulary and is a wonderful, active way to promote learning new words.

Throughout the day we will be enjoying reading activities and each student will come home with their £1 voucher for a World Book Day book.
