Read these interesting facts about animals with a parent, carer or teacher.



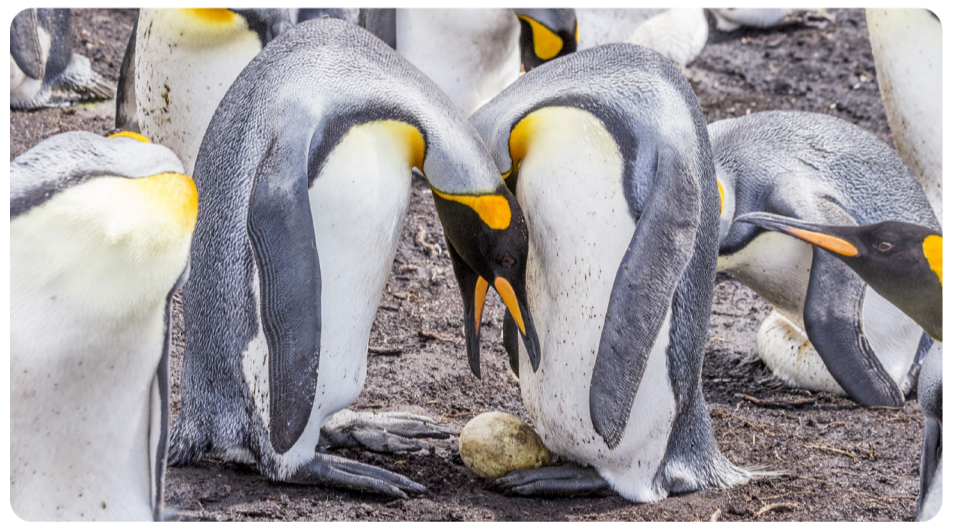
Carnivores eat other animals. Herbivores eat plants. Omnivores eat plants and other animals.

A habitat is a natural home for plants and animals. Animals need food, water and shelter to survive in their habitat.



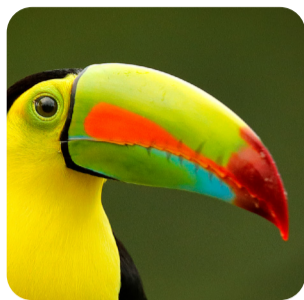
Camouflage is an animal's natural colouring or pattern that helps it blend in with its surroundings.



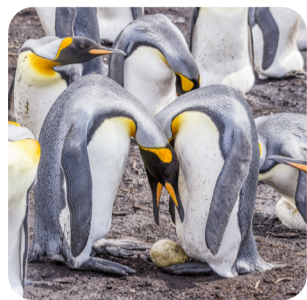

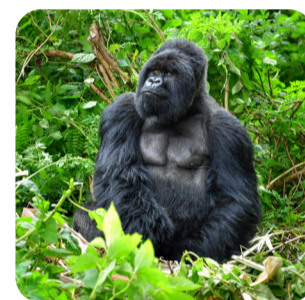

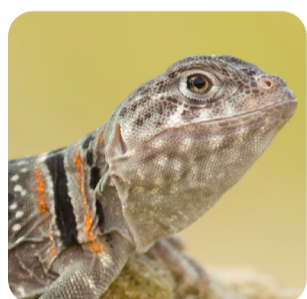
