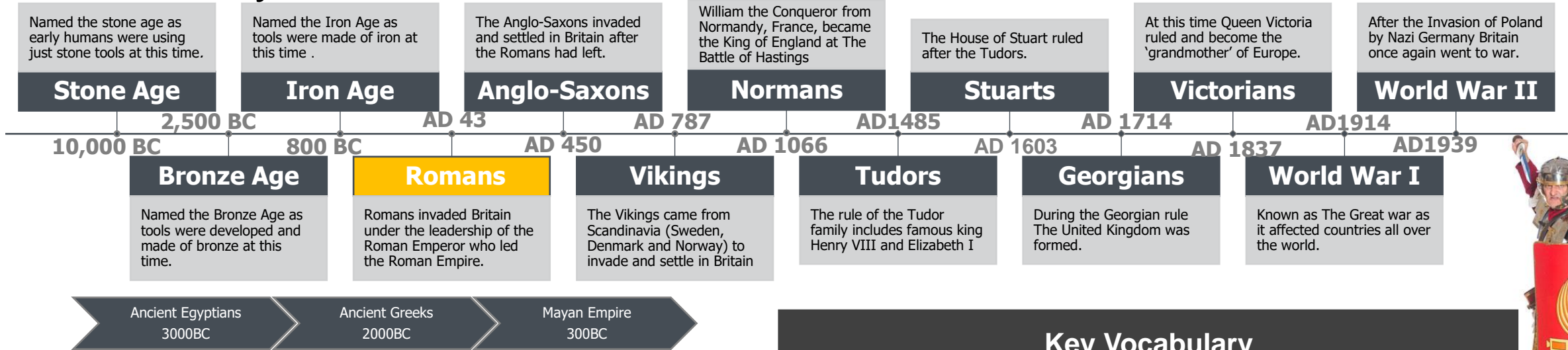


KS2 History - The Romans

Key Vocabulary

Romans	The Romans originated from the city of Rome in modern day Italy.
Empire	An extensive group of states or countries ruled over by a single ruler.
Emperor	The ruler of an empire.
Invade	To enter a country or land with the intention of occupying it
Gladiator	A man trained to fight with weapons against other men or wild animals in an arena
Campus	A training area for Roman soldiers
Mosaic	A picture or pattern produced by arranging together small pieces of stone, tile, glass, etc.
Slave	A person who was owned by another person and had to obey them.
Senate	The Roman senate was a governing and advisory assembly.
