Key Vocabulary

Continents	A continent is a massive area of land that is separated from others by water or other natural features. There are 7 continents on Earth, they are Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Australia, Europe, North America, and South America.
Europe	Europe is the second smallest of the world's seven continents.
Currency	Currency is the official money of a country . It consists of paper money and coins. Each country has its own form of currency.
Population	A population is the number of living people that live together in the same place .
Landmarks	A landmark is an object or a feature of a landscape or town that has importance or makes a place easily recognisable.
