There will be lots of exciting activities for the year 6 children, including: a leavers disco, afternoon tea and a visit to Buxton.

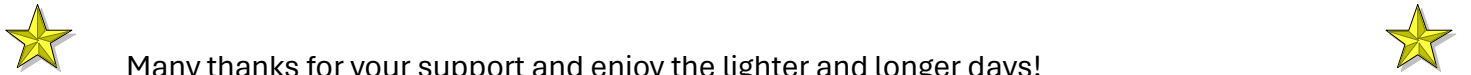
Those who are coming to Castleton will have a wonderful time. Please see the website for the information letter.
